

2017 Connecticut Big Bore Postal League
Operating Procedures
February 27, 2017

The 2017 Connecticut Big Bore Postal League will be conducted from April through September, fired at local ranges on the third Sunday of each month.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rules will apply except as noted below.

Course of Fire: Forty shots fired ten shots each in the prone, sitting, kneeling, and standing position with eight sighters in 45 minutes. Competitors may elect to shoot sitting kneeling and/or kneeling standing if desired.

In the event that a competitor knows that he will be unable to fire a match that competitor may fire that match in advance. No competitor may fire more than one match ahead at a time.

Date of Firing: While having the whole team shoot as a group on the third Sunday is desirable for logistics, coaching, and social reasons conflicts do exist. Therefore, teams may elect to shoot as a group on the third Sunday, or any other day either as a team or individuals. The only hard deadline is that the Team Captain must submit all scores no later than the last day of the month.

Rifle: Any safe and suitable centerfire fire rifle, NRA Rules 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.3.1, 3.3.2 with metallic sights or a telescopic sight that complies with NRA/CMP rules.

Distance: 100 or 200 yards

Targets: NRA SR-1 for 100 yards or Military SR for 200 yards

Entry Fee: None, although local clubs shall be able to charge a fee to cover expenses.

Awards:

Season awards for:

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place individuals

High Lady

High Junior

High Senior

High Service Rifle or High Match Rifle if service rifle wins

As we don't pay any entry fee the awards are simply bragging rights.

Score Reporting: Each team captain will be required to file a score report, either electronically or by mail, posted no later than the last day of the month to Hap Rocketto, 18 Stenton Avenue, Westerly, RI 02891 or hrocketto@cox.net

Match bulletins will be sent to all for whom Email addresses are provided on, or about, the fifth day of the month following the match.

Each Team Captain and competitor, for whom an Email address is submitted, will receive a bulletin prior to the third Sunday of each month and a final bulleting after the season ends. Team captains are encouraged to provide email addresses for each competitor.

The report must contain the competitors first and last name, email, or US Postal Service address, category, BBL Class if known, service or match rifle, and the aggregate score. See example below. Cards are no longer required.
