



Scholarship Program Information

- Purpose:** To provide financial assistance to junior shooters attending college.
- Eligibility:** Members in good standing of the CSRRA entering their first year of college.
- Budget:** Ten percent of the scholarship fund amount (as determined in the October Treasurer's report) will comprise the annual award total. Any donation or grants specifically designated for scholarships shall be added to the annual award total. Donations or grants designated for the scholarship fund shall increase the principal amount
- Number of Awards:** Two shall be given depending on applicant's application. All questions on the application must be answered to be considered for such scholarship. Any unanswered questions will forfeit your application for consideration.
- Deadline:** July 15th.

Selection of awardees shall be announced by August 1st each year.

- Selection Criteria:** All applicants will be evaluated on four equally important criteria:
1. Quality of their written statement
 2. Scholastic Record
 3. Citizenship which provides a positive role model for younger shooters
 4. Financial Aid (Including scholarships, grants, etc...)
- Selection Committee:** Each year, the President shall appoint three persons, one of which who may be an at-large member of the CSRRA, to evaluate the applications and select qualified applicants.
